ABOUT THE COLLEGE AND THE DEPARTMENT:

The erstwhile Government of Mysore was pleased to start a Law College on July 1, 1948 in Bangalore, known as the Government Law College. It was transferred to Bangalore University in the year 1964 and since then the college is known as University Law College and Department of studies in Law, Bengaluru. The University was shifted from the Central College Campus to the current campus in the year 2006. The college and Department of Studies in Law are housed in a spacious building situated on a sprawling campus. There are eight class rooms with state of the art facility to conduct teaching sessions for LL. B. & LL.M. programs, two seminar halls, an independent library and an administrative block providing independent chambers for Principal, Chairman & all teaching faculty members. The students and teachers are provided with computers with internet facility and the campus is also Wi-Fi enabled. In addition, the hostel facility is made available for both boys & girls. The new campus also has a rain harvesting system. The library at ULC is a well-equipped resource centre with an extensive collection of books, theses, law journals, newspapers, periodicals, and dissertations. It is also equipped with online subscriptions of leading publishers such as SCC Online, Manupatra, JSTOR, Oxford University Press, and Cambridge Press. Boasting an impressive collection of 38,970 books, 37 journals, 1128 dissertations, 97 Ph.D. thesis, 34 magazines and 12 newspapers, our library ensures that students and faculty have access to a diverse range of information. Furthermore, the library houses several research publications, enhancing the wealth of resources available to the ULC community.

Apart from the regular classroom teaching, the University Law College and Department of Studies in Law provides each students with skills in different areas. Presently, the college is headed by the Principal, Prof. Dr. N.Dashrath.

The Master degree in Law was started in the year 1960-61 as M.L. Degree course. After becoming part of the Bangalore University in, 1965, the Department of Studies in Law is offering two year LL.M programme in 6 different branches. The LL.M programme is offered in Corporate and Commercial Law, Constitutional and Legal Order, Criminal Law, Human Rights & Environmental Law, Labour & Employment Law has been a story of great success.
