A. GENERAL ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Candidates who have passed a three-year Bachelor's Degree / a four-year honours Degree examination of Bangalore University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto, with the respective subject as an Optional / Major / Special / Main subject, are eligible for admission to the relevant Postgraduate programmes, provided they fulfil the following conditions:

- i) The candidate must have secured a minimum of 40% marks in the aggregate of all subjects of the Bachelor's Degree.
- ii) The candidate must have secured a minimum of 50% marks in the qualifying optional/cognate subject(s) (i.e., the subject(s) relevant to the PG programme applied for) AND OR
- iii) The candidate must have secured at least 50% marks in the cognate subject.

Note: In case of (ii) and (iii), a minimum of 45% marks shall be required for SC/ST/Category-I and Persons with Disabilities (PWD) candidates.

B. FACULTY OF ARTS: M.A/ MPA/MVA/MSW Courses

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

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- i) The candidate must have secured a minimum of 40% marks in the aggregate of all subjects of the Bachelor's Degree.
- ii) The candidate must have secured a minimum of 50% marks in the qualifying optional/cognate subject(s) (i.e., the subject(s) relevant to the PG programme applied for) AND OR
- iii) The candidate must have secured at least 50% marks in the cognate subject.

Note: In case of (ii) and (iii), a minimum of 45% marks shall be required for SC/ST/Category-I and Persons with Disabilities (PWD) candidates.

1) M. A. in KANNADA: Graduates who have secured 40% in the aggregate of all subjects and 50% marks in the cognate subject in the qualifying University examinations are eligible. B.A., B.Sc. or B.Com. graduates who have secured at least 55% marks in the Language Kannada in the degree course are also eligible, provided they have passed Kannada Rathna or Pandit examination. If seats remain vacant B.A., B.Sc. or B.Com. graduates who have secured at least 50% marks in the Language Kannada in the degree course are also eligible.

2) M. A. in KANNADA (Taulanika): Graduates who have secured 40% in the aggregate of all subjects and 50% marks in the cognate subject in the qualifying University examinations are eligible. B.A., B.Sc. or B.Com. graduates who have secured at least 55% marks in the Language Kannada in the degree course are also eligible, provided they have passed Kannada Rathna or Pandit examination. If seats remain vacant B.A., B.Sc. or B.Com. graduates who have secured at least 50% marks in the Language Kannada in the degree course are also eligible.

3) M. A. in ENGLISH: Graduates who have secured 40% in the aggregate of all subjects and 50% marks in the cognate subject in the qualifying University examinations are eligible. Candidates with B.A., B.Sc. or B.Com Degree are eligible

provided they have scored 55% marks in the Language concerned in the degree course.

4) M. A. in TELUGU: Any degree with Telugu as second language/Optional Telugu/Advanced Telugu /Oriental Telugu (Arts/Science Commerce etc.) & must acquire 50% in Telugu Language and 50% as aggregate in degree exam.

5) M. A. in URDU: Graduates who have secured 40% in the aggregate of all subjects and 50% marks in the cognate subject in the qualifying University examinations are eligible. Candidates with B.A., B.Sc. or B.Com Degree are eligible provided they have scored 55% marks in the Language concerned in the degree course..

6) M. A. in HINDI: Candidates who have secured 40% marks in the aggregate of all the subjects and 50% of marks in the cognate subject at the Bachelor's Degree OR Candidates with a BA, B.Sc. or B.Com. Degree provided they have secured 50% marks in the Language Hindi in the Degree Course OR Students who have passed the Rashtra Bhasha Praveen Examination of Dakshina Bharath Hindi Prachar Sabha or equivalent examination of other Institutions, are eligible.

7) M. A. in SANSKRIT: Candidates who have passed with B.A./B.Sc./B.Com/ BBA/BBM/BCA/BHM Degree provided they have secured 55% marks in the Sanskrit Language in the Degree Course OR Students who have passed Sahitya Examination in Sanskrit/Sanskrit Bhasha Vidvat Madhyama/Pravesha Examination of Sura Saraswati Sabha Sringeri with Degree/Kovida Examination of Samskrita Bharathi with Degree/A Diploma Course in Sanskrit/Pali/Prakrita/Manuscriptology Certificate Course with Degree.

8) M. A. IN FRENCH/GERMAN/JAPANESE/SPANISH: Apart from general eligibility criteria, any graduates with French /German/ Japanese/Spanish as one of the subjects or as second language with 55% marks in the degree course or graduates with Diploma Superior of Alliance Franchise or Advance / Higher Diploma of any recognized University/Institute.

9) M. A. in ECONOMICS: Graduates with the economics as optional/cognate subject at the Bachelor's degree level or Graduates with Economics as a subject in the first three years of B.A., LLB 5 Years Integrated Degree Programme.

10) M. A. in HISTORY: Graduates with the History as optional/cognate subject at the Bachelor's degree level.

11) M. A. in SOCIOLOGY: Graduates with the Sociology as optional/cognate subject at the Bachelor's degree level.

12).M.A. in POLITICAL SCIENCE: Graduates with cognate subject (Political science/International Relations/Public Administration/Public Policy/Defense and Strategic Studies) at the Bachelor's Degree level. Graduates with Political Science as a subject in the first three years of Five-Years B.A.LL.B Programmes.

13) (a) M. A. in Journalism and Mass Communication: Graduates who have secured 50% of marks in Journalism (optional subject) at the Bachelor's Degree level. Graduates with at-least 50% marks in the aggregate of all the optional subjects at the Bachelor's Degree level.

(b) M.A. Media Studies, b) M.A. in Public Relations & Advertising: Any graduates

14) M. A. in PHILOSOPHY: Any graduates, preference is given to those who studied philosophy as optional along with others at the Bachelor's Degree level.

15) M. A. in RURAL DEVELOPMENT: Any graduates.

16) M. A. in WOMEN'S STUDIES: Any graduates and preference will be given to the graduates who have studied Women's Studies as a cognate subject.

17) MASTER OF PERFORMING ARTS (MPA):

a) M. P. A. in CARNATIC MUSIC (VOCAL/INSTRUMENTAL):

A degree with Music Vocal/Instrumental as one of the optional subject with at least 50% marks in the concerned optional subject on a merit intern among these applicants OR a graduate with a minimum of 50% marks secured in the Senior Grade Examination in Music (Vocal/Instrumental), conducted by Secondary Education Board of Karnataka OR a graduate with a minimum of 50% marks secured in PG Diploma or 2 years Diploma or 4 years Certificate Course in Vocal-Instrumental Music conducted either by any recognized University of any state outside Karnataka or Central Institutional/Universities. OR any degree with certificate course in Music OR All India Radio/Doordarshana with minimum of B-high grade OR Diploma in Music or Five years of learning certificate by any veteran musician.

b) M. P.A. in BHARATHANATYAM:

A graduate with Dance as one of the optional subject with at least 50% marks in the optional subject OR a graduate with a minimum of 50% marks in the Senior Grade Examination in Dance, conducted by the Karnataka Secondary Education Board/Karnataka State Gangubai Hanagal Music and Performing Arts University OR a graduate with a minimum of 50% marks in the PG Diploma or 2 years Diploma or 4 years Certificate Course in Dance from any recognized University or Institute or Doordarshana gradation with minimum of B-high grade. Diploma in dance or Five years of learning certificate by any veteran dancer.

c) **M.P.A in Theatre Arts:**

A graduate with Theatre / Drama / Dance / Music as cognate subject with 50% marks in the cognate subject OR any graduate with a Diploma / Certificate course in Theatre / Drama / Film Acting, conducted by a Department of Government of Karnataka / any State Government / Central Government OR any graduate with a Diploma (from Janapada Loka Affiliated to Bangalore University / Reputed Drama Institutes) / Certificate of Drama Workshops Conducted by Karnataka Nataka Academy or NSD.

18) MASTER OF SOCIAL WORK (M.S.W.): B.A./B.S.W. graduates from recognized Universities.

Candidates will be selected as per the general guidelines issued by Bangalore University. The university conducts an entrance examination for admission to the course. The department/University shall conduct an entrance examination for admission to the course.

The entrance examination is of two-hour duration and the question paper comprises of 100 objective type questions -20% questions form general knowledge, 60% from Science and Social Sciences, and another 20% questions will be from present social issues. Merit will be assessed based on performance in the entrance examination (50%) and performance in the undergraduate examination (50%) in equal weightage.

Eligibility under Deputation / Sponsored Category:

- a) Deputed Candidate means any candidate in permanent service deputed to undergo any postgraduate Programme by Central/State Government / Public Sector undertaking provided the candidate is a Graduate from any discipline with pass class.
- b) Sponsored Candidate is any graduate with pass class and with three years of service in the field of Social welfare in a recognized institution (Registered Social Service Organizations established under Societies/Trust/Companies Act.). The sponsoring Organization must give a certificate stating that the candidate is in employment for the past three years and give copies of last three years work reports and audited statements pertaining to that organizations.
- c) Such candidate shall pay the prescribed fee to the University along with the application.

19) MASTER OF VISUAL ARTS (M.V.A.) in Painting/Sculpture/ Print making/Animation/ Ceramics / Art History: Bachelor of Visual Arts/Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in respective discipline from recognized Universities or institutions.

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

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- (i) The candidate must have secured a minimum of 40% marks in the aggregate of all subjects of the Bachelor's Degree.
- (ii) The candidate must have secured a minimum of 50% marks in the qualifying optional/cognate subject(s) (i.e., the subject(s) relevant to the PG programme applied for) AND OR
- (iii) The candidate must have secured at least 50% marks in the cognate subject.

Note: In case of (ii) and (iii), a minimum of 45% marks shall be required for SC/ST/Category-I and Persons with Disabilities (PWD) candidates.

C) FACULTY OF SCIENCE:**GENERAL ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION**

Candidates who have passed a three-year Bachelor's Degree / a four-year honours Degree examination of Bangalore University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto, with the respective subject as an Optional / Major / Special / Main subject, are eligible for admission to the relevant Postgraduate programmes, provided they fulfil the following conditions:

- (i) The candidate must have secured a minimum of 40% marks in the aggregate of all subjects of the Bachelor's Degree.
- (ii) The candidate must have secured a minimum of 50% marks in the qualifying optional/cognate subject(s) (i.e., the subject(s) relevant to the PG programme applied for) AND OR
- (iii) The candidate must have secured at least 50% marks in the cognate subject.

Note: In case of (ii) and (iii), a minimum of 45% marks shall be required for SC/ST/Category-I and Persons with Disabilities (PWD) candidates.

- 1) M.Sc. in APPLIED GENETICS: B.Sc. graduates with any of the following subjects: Zoology, Applied Zoology, Chemistry, Bio- Chemistry, Botany, Applied Botany, Environmental Science, Microbiology, Biotechnology, Genetics, Applied Genetics and Sericulture.
- 2) M.Sc. in BIOCHEMISTRY: Graduates with Chemistry or Biochemistry (as cognate subject) and studied Biology at PUC or 10+2 level.
- 3) M.Sc. in BOTANY: Graduates with Botany/Applied Botany (cognate subject) as one of the subjects in the qualifying examination.
- 4) M.Sc. in CHEMISTRY: Graduates with Chemistry (cognate subject) as one of the subjects in the qualifying examination and studied Mathematics and Chemistry at 10 + 2 or PUC level.
- 5) M.Sc. in COMPUTER SCIENCE: B.Sc. graduates with Computer Science or B.C.A. with mathematics as one of the subjects OR B.Sc. PCM graduates with P.G. Diploma / Certificate Course in Computer Science of one year duration are eligible.
- 6) MASTER OF COMPUTER APPLICATIONS: As per AICTE norms.
- 7) M.Sc. in ELECTRONIC MEDIA, M.Sc. in GRAPHICS AND ANIMATION, M.Sc. in FILM MAKING: Any graduate.
- 8) M.Sc in Fashion and Apparel Design (FAD)
 - a) Graduates in Fashion and Apparel Design/Fashion Technology/Garment Manufacturing Technology/Costume Design and Fashion/Textile Technology/Silk Technology/Textile Design/Textile and Apparel Design/apparel Science.
 - b) *For sponsored candidates:* Bachelor's Degree with a minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate in optional subjects and employed in a reputed Institution / Organization with a minimum of 3 years of experience in the area of Apparel / Textile / Fashion Design.

- 9) M. Sc. in GEOGRAPHY & M. Sc. in GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SCIENCE: Any graduate from a recognized University. Preference will be given to candidates who have studied Geography as one of the optional subjects at the undergraduate level.
- 10) M. Sc. in GEOLOGY/ APPLIED GEOLOGY: Any B.Sc. graduates.
- 11) M.Sc. in FORENSIC SCIENCE: Candidates with undergraduate degree in B.Sc. Forensic Science/B.Sc. degree along with any of the two options as given viz; Forensic Science, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Botany, Mathematics, Biochemistry, Biotechnology, Microbiology, Toxicology, Life science, Anthropology and Psychology OR must have obtained the degree of LL.B (3 years/5 years) Course.
- 12) MASTER OF LIBRARY AND INFORMATION SCIENCE (M.L.I.Sc.): Any graduates.
- 13) M.Sc. in HUMAN CONSCIOUSNESS AND YOGIC SCIENCE: Any graduates First preference will be given to .P.G. Diploma in Yoga Studies with any degree OR Professional courses like BAMS, BNYS, BHMS, Unani, Siddi, etc. & have secured at least 50% in aggregate of degree exam. Second Preference: Certificate Course in Yoga Studies OR any Participation in State/National Workshop, Competitions, Camp with any Degree with 50%. in aggregate of degree exam.
- 14) M.Sc. in ELECTRONIC SCIENCE: A Science / BCA graduate with a minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate of all the optional subjects with the following: Physics/ Mathematics /Electronics /Instrumentation /Computer Science as one of the optional subject during their graduation program or BCA graduate who has studied Physics and Mathematics at the PUC/10+12/Diploma (Electronics/ Electrical /Instrumentation /Mechatronics/ AI & ML/Medical Electronic /Computer Science/Telecommunications) or equivalent, are eligible for admission to M.Sc in Electronic Science program. The admission procedures are as per the guidelines of the university.
- 15) M.Sc. in ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE: BSc/ BE graduates with any one of the following subjects: Physics/M.Sc. in ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE: Any B.Sc./ B.E. graduates studied chemistry or any one of the life science subjects either at degree level or at PU level (10+2). Graduates from agriculture/horticulture/forestry/fisheries and pharmacy, 50 % of the seats are reserved for students with environmental science as a cognate subject at degree level and remaining 50 % of seats for other disciplines. If seats are fallen vacant in either cases can be interchangeable.
- 16) B.Sc. graduates with Environmental Science as one of the cognate subjects. In the absence of such candidates, BSc graduates from Agriculture/Horticulture/ Forestry/Fisheries, or Engineering may be considered, provided they have studied at least one Life Science subject or Chemistry at the degree or at the PUC (10+2) level.
- 17) M. Sc. in LIFE SCIENCES: B.Sc. graduates with any Life Science Subject as one of the optional securing at least 50% marks in the aggregate of all optional subjects are eligible. B.Sc.(Agri) graduates are also eligible provided they have secured at least 50% marks in the aggregate of optional subjects.
- 18) M. Sc. in MATHEMATICS: Graduates with Mathematics as cognate subject.
- 19) M. Sc. in MICROBIOLOGY/ BIOTECHNOLOGY/ FOOD TECHNOLOGY:

- a) B.Sc. graduates with any Life Science Subject, securing at least 50% marks in aggregate of all optional subjects are eligible. B.Sc. graduates in Biotechnology and B.Sc. (Hons.) graduates in Biotechnology / Biology / Botany / Microbiology / Zoology are also eligible provided they have secured 50% marks in the aggregate of all the optional subjects.
 - b) In the absence of candidates in (a), Graduates in Agricultural Science, Dairy Sciences, Horticulture, Forestry, Fisheries, Pharmacy, Engineering (Biotechnology), Medicine / Dental or Agricultural Engineering, with 50% marks in the aggregate are eligible.
 - c) Bachelor degree in life science with subjects such as chemistry/ Biochemistry/ Biotechnology/Microbiology/Botany/Zoology/Food Technology/ Home Science/Food Science and Nutrition/ Food Science and Quality Control /Clinical Nutrition/Agriculture and B. Tech Degree in Biotechnology/ Agricultural Engineering.
- 20) M. Sc. in MOLECULAR BIOLOGY: Candidate who have studied B.Sc. degree with at least any one of the Life Science subjects (Botany, Zoology, Biotechnology, Microbiology, Molecular Biology, Genetics, Biochemistry, Applied Microbiology, Biosciences, B.Sc., Medical Lab Technology.
- 21) M. Sc. in PHYSICS: Graduates with Physics as a major/optional subject/special subject.
- 22) M. Sc. in PSYCHOLOGY: Graduates with Psychology as a cognate subject.
- 23) M. Sc. in PSYCHOLOGICAL COUNSELING: Graduates who have studied one paper/subject of Psychology/sociology/social work/Home Science/Human Resource Development (Management) at the graduate level or B.Ed. or P.G. Diploma in Counselling OR Graduate in any discipline of rehabilitation science, medical, paramedical, Nursing, Physiotherapy, speech therapy, Audiology.
- 24) M. Sc. in SERICULTURE: B.Sc. graduates with any Life Science Subjects or B.Sc. (Agri).
- 25) M. Sc. in STATISTICS: B.Sc. graduates with Statistics or Mathematics or Data Science as cognate subject.
- 26) **M.Sc in Natural Disaster Management:** Any B.Sc/ Civil Engineering graduates, Graduates from Geography as one of the optional subjects. Preference will be given to the graduates from earth science subjects like Geography, Geology and Environmental Science.

27) M. Sc. in ZOOLOGY: B.Sc. graduates with Zoology as cognate subject.

28) Integrated M.Sc. in GEOGRAPHY & GEOINFORMATICS: A candidate who has passed the two-year Pre-University Certification (PUC) Examination conducted by the Pre-University Education Board in Karnataka or 10+2 of CBSE or ICSE or any other examination considered as equivalent to that of PUC from any state / country with science stream and Geography as one of the subjects in case of Arts and Commerce stream.

26) HOME SCIENCE RELATED PROGRAMMES

a) M.Sc. in CLINICAL NUTRITION AND DIETETICS: Graduates with the following order of priority a) Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics b) Nutrition and Dietetics and c) Medical graduates – MBBS.

b) M.Sc. in EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION AND ADMINISTRATION: Any Graduates. Three seats are earmarked for professionals sponsored by recognized institutions in the field of Early Child Care/Education and International students. Students from non-Home Science, Non-education and non-psychology background are required to complete a foundation course in the first semester along with the regular course of the first semester.

c) M.Sc. in EXTENSION EDUCATION AND COMMUNICATION: Any graduates. Preference will be given to students who have studied Home Science at the Undergraduate level. Non-Home Science background students are required to complete a Foundation course in the First Semester along with the regular courses of the First Semester.

d) M.Sc. in FOOD AND NUTRITION: Any graduates in the following order of priority: Graduates in a) food and Nutrition, b) clinical nutrition and Dietetics, c) Food Science and Nutrition d) Science and Technology, d) Science with Home Science as optional e) Biotechnology, Microbiology and Biochemistry, g) Ayurvedic Medicine, Homeopathy and Naturopathy, and h) Nursing.

e) M. Sc. in HUMAN DEVELOPMENT, M.Sc. in RESOURCE MANAGEMENT: Any graduates. Preference will be given to students who have studied Home Science at the graduate level. Students from Non – Home Science background are required to complete a Foundation course in the First Semester along with the regular courses of the First Semester.

f) M.Sc. in TEXTILES AND CLOTHING: B.Sc. graduates with integrated / Composite Home Science / B.Sc. with Home Science as one optional/Home Science & Chemistry / Wet Processing / Fashion & Apparel Design.

27) SPEECH AND HEARING PROGRAMMES

M.Sc. in AUDIOLOGY (MSc AUD), M.Sc. in SPEECH LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY (M.Sc. SLP): Graduates in BASLP (Bachelor of Science in Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology).

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- (i) The candidate must have secured a minimum of 40% marks in the aggregate of all subjects of the Bachelor's Degree.
- (ii) The candidate must have secured a minimum of 50% marks in the qualifying optional/cognate subject(s) (i.e., the subject(s) relevant to the PG programme applied for) AND OR
- (iii) The candidate must have secured at least 50% marks in the cognate subject.

Note: In case of (ii) and (iii), a minimum of 45% marks shall be required for SC/ST/Category-I and Persons with Disabilities (PwD) candidates.

- 1) MASTER OF COMMERCE (M. Com): Graduates who have passed the three-year B.Com./ B.B.A/BBM. examination of Bangalore University or any other Universities.
- 2) MASTER OF COMMERCE FINTECH & AI : Graduates who have passed the three-year B.Com./ B.B.A/BBM. examination of Bangalore University or any other Universities.
- 3) MASTER OF COMMERCE (FINANCIAL ANALYSIS) / M.Com (F.A.): The eligibility criteria for the M.Com (Fin. Tech & AI) programme also requires that at least one of the following qualifications be obtained from an educational institution in Karnataka Class 10 (SSC/ SSLC) or Class 12 (PU) or an under graduate degree with a minimum aggregate score of 50%.
- 4) MASTER OF TOURISM AND TRAVEL MANAGEMENT (M.T.T.M.): Candidates who have passed Bachelor's or Master's Degree Examination of Bangalore University or any other University in Commerce, Management, Arts, Social Sciences, Science, Engineering / Technology.

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

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- (i) The candidate must have secured a minimum of 40% marks in the aggregate of all subjects of the Bachelor's Degree.
- (ii) The candidate must have secured a minimum of 50% marks in the qualifying optional/cognate subject(s) (i.e., the subject(s) relevant to the PG programme applied for) AND OR
- (iii) The candidate must have secured at least 50% marks in the cognate subject.

Course Offered – Master of Education (M.Ed.)

Eligibility for M.Ed.

A candidate who has passed the B.Ed. examination of this University or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto shall be eligible for admission to the course, provided he/she has secured at least 50% marks in the aggregate. However candidates who are deputed by the Government of Karnataka to the course are exempted from the above eligibility condition.

A. Courses Offered -

a) Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed.)

b) Master of Physical Education (M.P.Ed.)

B. Nature of Courses - 2 Years (4 Semesters)

Eligibility criteria for the B.P.Ed.

Any graduate of Bangalore University or of any other University recognized by the Bangalore University as equivalent thereto who is physically fit and satisfies any of the following conditions will be eligible for admission to B. P. Ed. Degree Course.

- a. Bachelor's Degree in any discipline with 50% marks and having at least participation in the Inter-College/Inter-Zonal/District/School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.
OR
- b. Bachelor's Degree in Physical Education with 45% marks.
OR
- c. Bachelor's Degree in any discipline with 45% marks and studied physical education as compulsory elective subject.
OR
- d. Bachelor's Degree with 45% marks and having participated in National/Inter University State competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in Inter College/Inter-Zonal/District/School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.

OR

- e. **Bachelor's Degree with participation in international competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in National/Inter-University competition in sports and games as recognized by the respective federations/AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.**

OR

- f. **Graduation with 45% marks and at least three years of teaching experience (for deputed in-service candidates i.e. trained Physical Education teachers/coaches.**

b) Eligibility for M.P.Ed.

Minimum Requirement for Admission:

1. **Pass in Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed) Degree course of Bangalore University or of any other University considered as equivalent there to, securing at least 50% Marks.**
2. **Outstanding sports person means a candidate who has participated in recognized Inter-University/Interstate/International sports or games competitions.**
3. **All candidates shall produce a Medical fitness certificate issued by a medical Officer of not less than the rank of District Surgeon.**

Selection procedure for M.P.Ed course:

Candidates shall be selected on the basis of merit. Merit shall be determined on the basis of candidate's performance in the qualifying examination, entrance test and his/her achievement in sports and games.

The weightage shall be given as follow:-

- i) **40% marks obtained in the qualifying examination**
- ii) **30% of marks obtained in the entrance test.**
- iii) **30% Marks for physical fitness tests performance.**

Merit list will be announced as per above procedure. Seats will be allotted as per University guidelines. The reservation of seats will be as per the Policies of State Government from time to time.
